## THREE CARD POKER

Three Card Poker offers two games in one. Players choose to play against the dealer, or based on how good their cards are, or both. The object of Three Card Poker is to make the best poker hand possible using only three cards.

Three Card Poker is played with standard 52-card deck. The cards are distributed by the dealer in groups of three from an automatic shuffling machine. The payouts are printed on the table at each player spot.

## HOW TO PLAY THREE CARD POKER

To begin a round, the player places a wager on the ante and/ or the Pair Plus bet. The ante wager indicates the player wants to compare their hand against the dealer, and the pair plus is a wager that the player will have a hand with at least a pair or better.

Three cards are dealt to each player and the dealer. Players only play against the dealer, and not any of the other players at the table.

Players look at their hand to determine whether or not to place a play wager (a bet equal to the amount of their ante wager,) to compare their hand against the dealer's hand or not.

If the player folds, the hand is over and the dealer collects the player's ante wager and the pair plus wager. If the player places a play wager, the cards will be revealed to determine if the player has a better hand than the dealer.

If the dealer has a hand of Jack-high or worse, the play wager is returned to the player and the ante bet is paid 1 to 1 . If the dealer has a hand of Queen-high or better, both the play wager and ante are paid 1 to 1 if the player has a better hand than the dealer. If the dealers hand is better, both the ante and play bets are collected.

The pair plus bet is determined independently to the play and ante wager.

## RANKING OF HANDS FROM HIGHEST TO LOWEST:

Straight Flush, Three of a Kind, Straight, Flush, and Pair.

## THREE CARD POKER PROGRESSIVE

## PROGRESSIVE PAYOUTS

The optional $\$ 1$ progressive bet wins if you have a Straight or better. See paytable for odds. If you receive an Ace-King-Queen of Spades, you win $100 \%$ of the progressive Jackpot.

## ENVY BONUSES

If you have placed the optional \$1 Progressive Jackpot wager, you are eligible for the Envy Bonus. The top two hands trigger Envy Bonuses and you win if any other player gets Ace-KingQueen (AKQ) suited or AKQ of spades. You can win multiple Envy Bonuses in a round, but you cannot receive Envy Bonuses for your own hand or the dealer's hand.

## HOUSE RULES

Players may play more than one hand at supervisor's discretion. Side betting is strictly prohibited on the casino floor. All decisions made by the Floor Supervisor are final.
